	Many choose to attend local fundraising or health promotion events, or to give talks to local groups but this is not essential.
	We are looking for volunteers who will be available over the long term to build up contacts and relationships within their own community.
Essential Skills / Qualifications	You don't need any particular skills or qualifications for this role, but it is important that you enjoy working on your own initiative . As the role involves getting out and about chatting to people you should be sociable and have good interpersonal skills .
	You should be motivated, possess good organisational skills and want to help make a difference. Experience in public speaking is an advantage for any presentations or talks you might choose to give.
Training & Support	Full support will be provided by Cancer Focus NI, together with any necessary
	training required to help you fulfil this role. 'Out of pocket' expenses will be reimbursed in line with agreed guidelines
