



Treasure Hunt

Notes for Teacher:

1. Ask pupils to work in pairs.

2. Print out the Treasure Hunt below along with one answer sheet per pair.

3. Laminate and cut out the letters.

4. Hide the letters within the school playground or classroom

5. Ask pupils, working in pairs to find each letter, record the letter and unscramble the code word. (see code word solutions below.)

6. When each pair has found all the letters, they must unscramble the letters to find the phrase "No Smoking Day"

7. The first pair to complete steps 5 & 6 must then locate a teacher (or classroom assistant) and give them the completed worksheet. The first pair to reach the teacher/classroom assistant wins!
